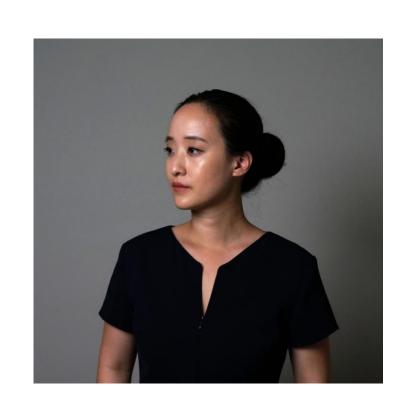

HELP ADVOCATE FOR POSTPARTUM LEGISLATION IN MASSACHUSETTS

Support MA postpartum psychosis and depression legislation, H.1828; S.1085, "An Act Relative to the Well-Being of New Mothers and Infants."

It is an incredible, comprehensive postpartum bill that provides mental health treatment, a conditional release program, and a relief from judgement or post-conviction clause so that those currently incarcerated in MA would benefit from the law. This legislation can prevent postpartum tragedies and save lives of mothers and babies by increasing awareness and early intervention.

The Judiciary Committee of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts is in process of determining the fate of this important postpartum legislation.
